CALCUTTA RULES

PARTICIPANTS

Any member in good standing of the Hide-A-Way Hills Club, as defined by the HAH Code of Regulations, may participate. By September 5th, all players must have a Hide-A-Way Hills handicap established from a minimum of ten scores accumulated during the current season. Teams will be selected in a blind-draw from groups divided according to this handicap.

An entry fee of \$10.00 must be paid by all golfers at the time of sign up.

After a maximum of 72 players are signed, other qualified golfers will be allowed to sign up on a stand-by list.

AUCTION

An auction will be held to "sell" the teams. At this time, members in good standing of HAH may "bid" on the teams. The highest bid will be declared the winner. At this time, the team has the option to "buy back" up to 50% of their team. If this option is exercised, any winnings will be split with the owner by percentage. If the team chooses not to exercise this right, the owner will receive 100% of any winnings.

FORMAT

The match is an 18-hole scramble. Each player will tee-off from each tee. Men use white tees front nine and blue tees back nine. Women use red tees front nine and yellow tees back nine. The team then selects one of these shots to continue play. If the ball selected is in the sand, all shots can be raked and placed. All players then hit shots from this location. This continues from tee to green. (See Rule 3)

After completion of 18 holes, the lowest score will determine the winner. In case of ties, a sudden-death format will be used starting on hole #1 and continuing with 2, 7, 8 & 9, and back to #1 until a winner is determined.

PRIZE MONEY

Five (5) places will be paid, based on a percentage of total auction proceeds as follows:

50%-First place

20%-Second place

15%-Third place

10%-Fourth place

5%-Fifth place

TOURNAMENT RULES

All HAH Golf Committee rules will be enforced throughout play.

- 1. During a playoff, each player shall identify their ball with their team number.
- 2. On the day of the tournament, if any entry cannot play for emergency reasons, the team and owner have the following options:
 - a. A golfer of equal handicap or higher may be selected from the "stand-by list" to replace the missing entry.
 - b. The owners and team members may elect to withdraw and receive their money and entry fee back.
 - c. The owner may sell his or her portion of the team to the members of the team and still play.
 - d. The members of the team may sell their share to the owner and still play.
- 3. Selected shot shall be played within one club length from shot except from traps, water, out of bounds and greens (no closer to the hole). Club length shall not improve lie from rough to fairway or fairway to green.

 Balls played from the sand may be raked and placed after the first shot is played. The first shot from sand does not have to be played by the player that hit it in.
- 4. All Putts must be holed. (NO GIMMEES)
- 5. USGA Rules apply.
